AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP'S CODE CHAPTER 142 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC) ARTICLE II (TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) SECTION 142-21 (STOP INTERSECTIONS ESTABLISHED) TO ADD A STOP SIGN TO BE PLACED NORTHBOUND and SOUTHBOUND ON SHEFFIELD DRIVE AT NETHERWOOD ROAD MAKING THE INTERSECTION AN ALL-WAY STOP INTERSECTION.

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Whitpain Township Board of Supervisors as follows:

SECTION 1. Amendment to Chapter 142 [Vehicles and Traffic] Article II [Traffic Regulations] Section 142-21 [Stop Intersections Established].

The Township's Code Chapter 142 (Vehicles and Traffic) Article II (Traffic Regulations) Section 142-21 (Stop Intersections Established) shall be amended to add a stop sign to the following intersection: Northbound and Southbound on Sheffield Drive at Netherwood Road, making the intersection an all-way stop intersection. Specifically, the stop signs to be added are as follows:

Stop Street	Intersecting or Through Street	Direction of Travel
Sheffield Drive	Netherwood Road	northbound
Sheffield Drive	Netherwood Road	southbound

SECTION 2. Repeal and Ratification.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith or in conflict with any of the specific terms enacted hereby, to the extent of said inconsistencies or conflicts, are hereby specifically repealed. Any other terms and provisions of

the Township's Code unaffected by this Ordinance are hereby reaffirmed and ratified.

SECTION 3. Severability.

Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase in this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and affect, and for this reason the provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable.

SECTION 4. Effective Date.


This Ordinance shall become effective 5 days after enactment.
