PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION:

This house is an example of the Penn Plan mode of Colonial architecture. Sitting perpendicular to Yost Road, the house consists of a two story stone core, a two-story frame end addition, and a garage attached to the addition. The c. 1730 core has an end-gabled roof clad with wood shingles. Its walls are composed of uncoursed stone, which was formerly clad with stucco. Windows are new sash. A single door on each side of the structure sits under a pediment supported by Doric pilasters.

The addition assumes the core's roofline. The frame addition, clad in weatherboard, was probably constructed in the late 1800s. The core measures 20' x 20'; house measures 20' by 45', plus the garage.

Classification: The house is a fine example of the Penn Plan and one of the oldest houses in the Township. However, the house's alterations and garage addition make it a Class II resource.
