#### PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION:

This Second Empire style house consists of a Mansard roofed core, a 2-story addition, a 1-story addition creating an overall ell-shape, plus a barn and a garage.

The core features a classical Second Empire style Mansard roof, topped with an exaggerated wood cornice and thick molding under the eaves. The 3-bay house is 3-stories high with stucco-clad walls. Fenestration includes 2 gabled dormers on each side of the roof, and 1x1 sash windows throughout the first and second floor. A new main entrance door, with sidelights, is located under a wrap around, shed-roofed porch on the front and south facades. The core measures 20'x 30'.

Attached to the rear of the core is a two story, stucco-clad addition, with a flat roof. While the eave molding continues from the core around the addition, its roof if flat, thus accentuating the core's Mansard roof. Attached to the rear of the addition, on the southeastern corner is a 1-story, gabled roof extension. The frame addition is also clad in stucco. It creates an overall ell-shape. Combined, the house measures 35'x 55'.
